We are delighted to offer your daughter the opportunity to participate in the Methodist Ladies' College Thailand Conservation Experience in 2018. This is an opportunity for up to 22 students to be of service in another part of the world. The application pack for this exciting service learning opportunity is outlined below, it is timely to remind you that your daughter should complete this application as independently as possible. This part of the process is important for students to demonstrate their level of commitment to participating in this sought after learning experience. It is important too that I reiterate that students who participate in the 2018 Elephant Conservation trip are not eligible to apply for the Bethany Home and Vietnam Service Learning Trips in 2019. This ensures as many students as possible benefit from these incredible service learning experiences.

### **Medical Information and Vaccinations**

As we already have your daughter's medical details on file at the College we will send you an update form to provide relevant medical information closer to the trip's departure date.

If your daughter is selected, please check with your doctor regarding required vaccinations for Thailand.

### **Insurance**

Travel insurance for your daughter is included in the trip cost. We are also pleased to advise that the Thailand Service Learning Trip will be supported by International SOS, an organisation that provides 24/7 assistance with medical, security and logistical matters while the group is away. In conjunction with the ongoing involvement of staff at the College, this gives each group immediate access to qualified, experienced assistance in managing any issues that may arise.

### **Passports**

All students must have a valid and up to date full passport for travel to Asia. For travel to Thailand all passports must have a 6 month validity from the date of arrival into that country.

### **Costing**

The final cost of the tour, excluding personal spending money, is approximately **\$3,700** for this learning experience (based on 2017). This amount will be finalised as soon as possible. It will cover accommodation, meals, airfare, travel insurance, taxes, excursions, coach transport and tour guide hire.

### **Spending Money**

Students will only need money for souvenirs and other sightseeing activities that are not included in the itinerary.
