Methodist Ladies' College Music Prize auditions are open to students in Years 6 to 10 in 2018. Please return your completed form, along with your reference, to the Music Department by Monday 31 July 2017.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

REMISSION OF TUITION FEES

Up to 10 Instrumental Music Prizes will be offered to students entering Year 6 in 2018.

Up to 15 Instrumental Music Prizes will be offered to students entering Years 7 or 8 in 2018.

Up to 12 Instrumental and Vocal Music Prizes will be offered to students entering Years 9 or 10 in 2018.

Vocal prizes are not awarded to students in Years 6-8.

Music prizes provide 50 per cent of the cost of instrumental (orchestral or band instrument) or vocal tuition for 32 lessons and the free use of a College instrument, subject to availability. It is expected that all students with a Music Prize will enrol in Class Music and participate in a minimum of two co-curricular music ensembles.

REQUIREMENTS

The attached form must be completed and returned to the Music Department, along with a reference from the candidate's present Instrumental or Vocal Music Teacher. For the audition, candidates will be required to perform two contrasting pieces on their principle instrument. Candidates may additionally play one piece on their second instrument, if applicable. A copy of all music must be provided for the adjudicator and a copy for the accompanist. There will also be aural tests and a viva voce (short informal interview).

AUDITIONS AND INFORMATION

Music Prizes are offered on the results of audition, which is based on performance ability, general musicianship and musical potential. Auditions will take place from Monday 14 August to Thursday 17 August 2017 and audition times will be visible on Connect.S and Connect.P by Monday 7 August 2017. The audition will last approximately 10 minutes. For accompanied pieces, candidates must provide their own accompanist or arrange a session with a College accompanist, through the Music Administrator, which will then be charged to student fee accounts. The closing date for applications is Monday 31 July 2017.

Students will not normally be awarded a music prize more than twice during their time at MLC.
